

Preservation. "Our early history is so fantastic. The Lawrences were so influential," Fagnan said. "It's a great recognition, a great protection and a great addition to the whole history of the Town of Catharine. It makes a place special." With the exception of only a handful of years, the Chapel has been used for church services, baptisms, weddings, funerals, musical performances and lectures since the first event there in July 1881. The Schuyler County Historical Society offers the Chapel for community use from May through October. "The Lawrence Chapel sits on a serene hill just above the road. Perfectly nestled among the trees, the location is elegant and calming," Society Executive Director of Museums Heather O'Grady-Evans said. "Newly restored interior walls make the acoustics inside the Chapel perfect for intimate vocal and instrumental concerts, renewal ceremonies and small weddings. "That the Chapel is now on the state and national registries adds to its mystique and historic charm. Each event held

part of its rich history." The Chapel's original wooden pews can seat up to 120 guests. The altar pieces are also original, as are the stained-glass windows. 

a vasectomy, the testicles still make sperm, but the body absorbs them. A vasectomy prevents pregnancy better than any other

method of birth control, except abstinence. How is the procedure done?

Melanie McNally, MD

Vasectomy takes about 20 minutes, and most vasectomies done by Cayuga Urology are performed in the doctor's office.

What should a patient expect after surgery?

The surgical area will be numb for a few hours after a vasectomy. Mild discomfort or pain for the first few days is normal and should be treated with over-the-counter pain relievers. Wearing snug underwear or a jockstrap will help ease discomfort and support the area.

What are the risks of vasectomy?

About one to two percent of men may have ongoing pain or discomfort after a vasectomy. The pain is usually treated with anti-inflammatory drugs, like ibuprofen.



When can normal activities resume?

Most men with desk jobs return to work in one or two days and should avoid heavy lifting for a week. Men with more active jobs that include heavy lifting may need more time off.

Sex can resume as soon as a man and his partner are comfortable. However, even after a vasectomy, sperm can still be in the semen, making another form of contraception necessary to prevent an unintended pregnancy. After about three months, the man's semen is tested to determine if his sperm count is zero or there are less than 100,000 sperm and none are moving.




