UPLIFTING HISTORY! GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY FOR THE BRICK TAVERN MUSEUM. The Schuyler County Historical Society will hold the groundbreaking ceremony for the Uplifting History! capital project on October 29, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. The ceremony will be held at 108 N. Catharine Street in Montour Falls. Senator Tom O'Mara said, "It's a fantastic milestone for the Schuyler County Historical Society and the village of Montour Falls, and an exciting testament to the success of the 'Uplifting History' campaign! It's one of the latest and best examples of how investment through the NY Forward program can help spark vital community development and local pride, and we're grateful to all of the local leaders and area residents working so tirelessly for the future of Schuyler County and the entire region." In May of 2024, the Schuyler County Historical Society received \$792,000 from the NY Forward Montour Falls development monies. The organization had been preparing for this accessibility renovation for nearly a decade. Assemblyman Phil Palmesano commented, "Congratulations to the Schuyler County Historical Society and the surrounding area on this important grant award. This funding will provide the critically necessary resources to assist with building the new addition to the Brick Tavern Museum. As the oldest brick building in Schuyler County, built in 1828, there is no better foundation to build upon to showcase the rich, deep cultural history in Schuyler County. The Brick Tavern Museum will turn 200 in 2028 and requires preservation and modern updates for accessibility. To that end, the capital campaign Uplifting History! was launched in March of this year. "This is a proud day for Montour Falls," Mayor Ryan said. "The Brick Tavern has stood as a symbol of our rich history for generations, and now, thanks to the investment from NY Forward, it will continue serving our community in a renewed and vibrant way. The Historical Society's leadership and dedication set a high bar for the future projects we'll see in our village. This groundbreaking is more than just the start of construction – it's the beginning of a new chapter in preserving and celebrating our heritage." The capital project will create modern archives, allowing the museum to add to the more than 3,000 family names already in the research library. The ad-

ditional archive space will provide an opportunity to add to the museum's collection of Schuyler County artifacts. "We can't move forward without knowing where we've been," noted FLX Gateway Executive Director Judy McKinney Cherry. "That's what this groundbreaking is all about-taking steps to ensure that future generations of Schuyler County residents and visitors will have access to the history that makes this place so special." Post construction, two new exhibition areas will open up, and many of the spaces will be updated. Most importantly, every visitor will be able to enjoy the same experience as the new elevator assists in getting people to the second floor, where the majority of the exhibition spaces are. Watkins Glen Area Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Nigar Hale said, "We are thrilled to break ground on the only chartered museum in Schuyler County. This project will bring long-overdue upgrades in accessibility, preservation, and visitor experience-transforming what the museum can offer our community." The Brick Tavern

Museum will be open the day of the groundbreaking ceremony and will remain open until at least October 31, 2025. The public is welcome at the groundbreaking ceremony and to visit "200 Years: Seneca Lake & the Erie Canal Waterways." After November 1, the hours of the museum will be updated based on the construction schedule. Finally, "Construction to the Brick Tavern Museum is not just a once-in-100-year chance for museum preservation," said Heather O'Grady-Evans, Executive Director of Museums. "All of this is about opportunities. The op-

portunity to preserve, grow, renew and develop new experiences for everyone." See you at the museum! The Brick Tavern Museum is located at 108 N. Catharine St./Route 14, Montour Falls. Admission is free. Voters now have **nine extra days** to vote prior to the General Election at an Early Voting location. Everyone who is registered to vote in New York State, a resident of Schuyler County, is eligible to vote at our Early Voting site. Each site is fully accessible to voters with physical disabilities. Voters do not need to have an “excuse” for voting early. Once they have cast their ballot on a machine at the Early Voting site, they will not be able to vote on Election Day.
