The new segment, shown on Map M14 of the FLT, begins on the east side of Sugar Hill State Forest at "Ebenezer's Crossing" on Templar Road, where shoulder parking is available. From there, the route crosses Templar Road and heads northeast across Glen Creek to VanZandt Hollow Road, where there is roadside parking just east of the bridge and a short walk to

From VanZandt Hollow Road the trail crosses the Columbia and Empire pipeline corridors, then enters land owned by the Finger Lakes Trail Conference (FLTC). It follows the north bank of Glen Creek for roughly a half mile, offering a quiet creekside walk before turning south, crossing the stream, and entering Watkins Glen State Park to rejoin the existing FLT

Hikers can use the new route to reach the Village of Watkins Glen or to create loop hikes that combine the FLT, park trails, and nearby roads. The reroute significantly reduces road walking in this part of the FLT and provides a new way to experience Glen Creek.

Trail stewards emphasize that the new route should only be used when water levels in Glen Creek are normal. During or immediately after heavy rainfall or spring snowmelt, hikers should follow the signed "high water route," which keeps them on roads and higher ground.

FLTC and Watkins Glen State Park are also in discussion about eventually adding the FLTC property along Glen Creek to the state park, which would further secure the long-term route of the FLT in this area. The project was completed by volunteer trail crews, Bill Meehan, FLTC staff, state partners, and the Columbia and Empire companies, with support from donors to the Sidote Trail Preservation Fund.


PA. Howard served his country honorably for three years with the US Army, with tours in Korea and Vietnam.

ODESSA HISTORY TALKS 2026: With Gary Emerson, Schuyler County Historian, All programs begin at 10am. Village of Odessa Community Room, No Registration Required. Lehigh Valley Railroad - January 17th. The Lehigh Valley Railroad arrived in Schuyler County in the early 1890s when the tracks were built along the east side of Seneca Lake. Several large culverts were built to carry the railroad over some of the deep ravines along the lake and there is one right in the village of Odessa. The Lehigh Valley Railroad changed the villages it passed through as it brought passenger service, milk transport, and other services to improve the lives of the people along the tracks in Odessa, Burdett, and Hector. Crimes, Chaos, and Craziness on the Chemung Canal - February 21st. When we think about the Chemung Canal, we tend to focus on the important changes it brought to the area in the realms of transportation, commerce, and population growth. But there was a darker side to the canal's history as well. For many of the working-class people who lived near and worked on the canal, the canal was not necessarily the harbinger of progress. This talk will reveal the violent and strange events that were once part of the canal culture in our communities, including murders, strikes, thievery, fighting, and other bizarre incidents. CCC Camps in Schuyler County March 21st. During the Great Depression, the Civilian Conservation Corps was created to provide work to unemployed young men. Schuyler County had four CCC camps that worked to plant trees, promote soil conservation, and build parks for recreation. This presentation will use maps, photos, and newspaper articles
